

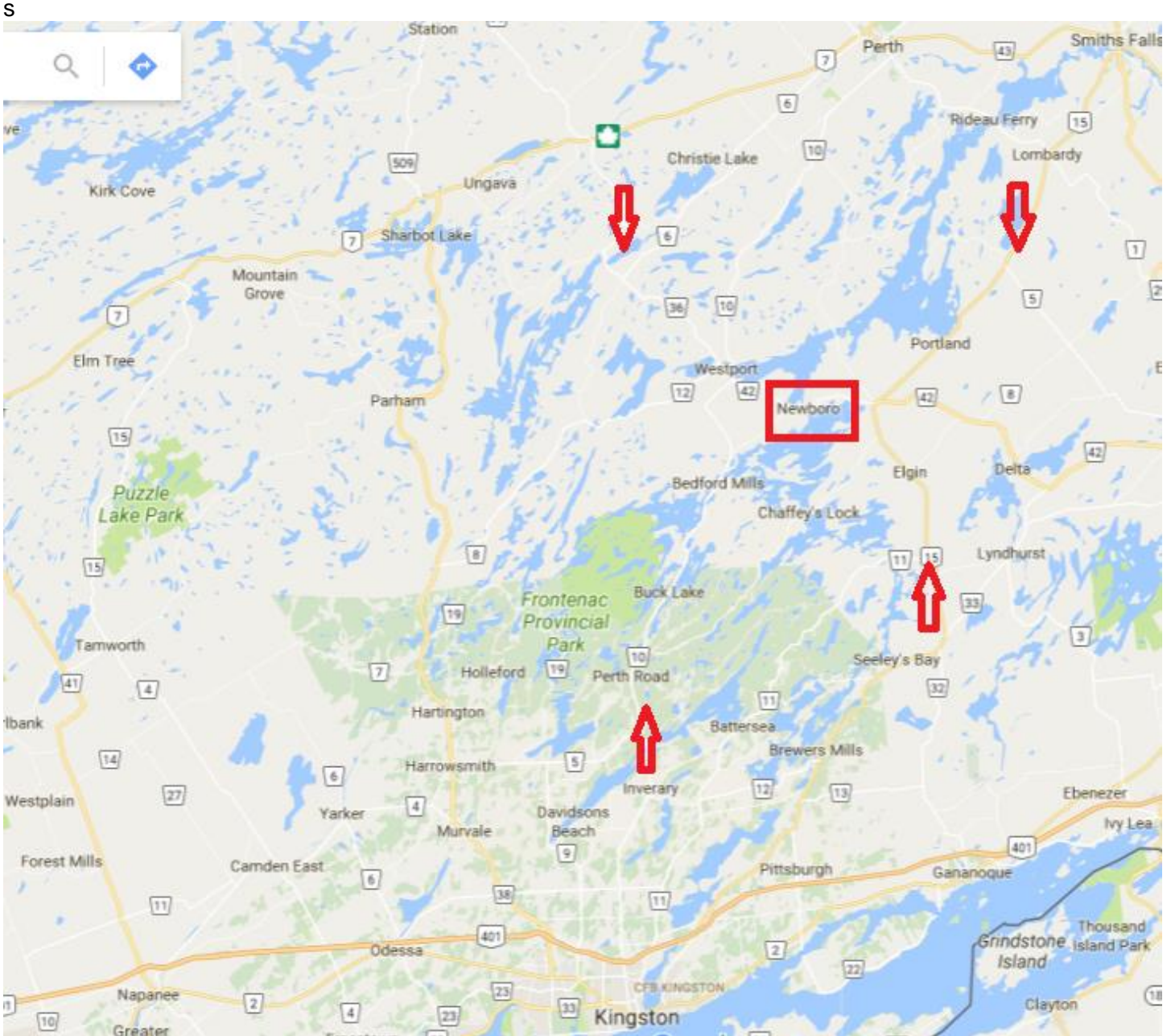
Holder Island on Newboro Lake

HOW TO GET THERE

Here are some maps and instructions for finding your way to the village of Newboro, where you can then get to the Newboro Wharf, park your vehicle, and then paddle your canoe or catch a boat ride to Holder Island!

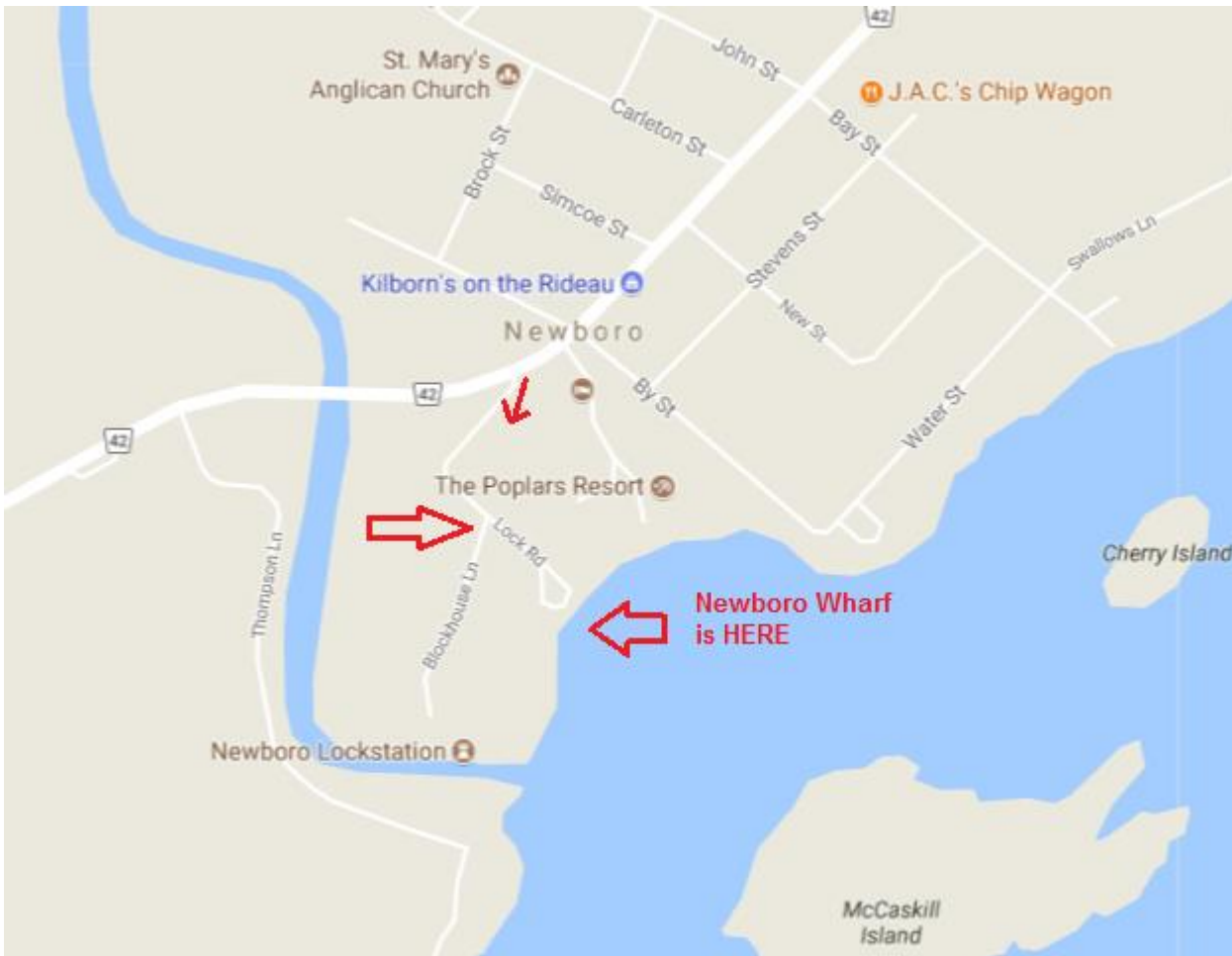
* PLEASE USE THIS GUIDE - we have reports from other visitors that in some cases Google/GPS systems DO NOT accurately bring them to the correct location when such coordinates are entered.

1. Make your way to the village of Newboro, which is about 1 hour north of the 401/Kingston area, about 30 minutes from Smiths Falls, and 5 minutes away from the village of Westport:



2. When you get to Newboro...

Head for the West end of the village, just past Kilborn's store and Stirling Lodge, and look for "LOCK Rd.", just east of where the canal crosses the main street:



3. Follow Lock Rd. to the end where you will find the wharf and parking lot.

4. Park your car in the lot at the wharf, and pay for your parking (currently \$3 per day, pay the attendant if one is there, otherwise you have to put the money in a tiny envelope with your licence plate# and drop it into a mail slot on the kiosk at the dock).

5a. IF YOU REQUIRE TRANSPORTATION TO THE ISLAND (from us)...

Call us when you think you are about 30-minutes away from Newboro, so that we can get ourselves over to the wharf with a boat to meet you. Try these numbers, in the following order:

5b. IF you have negotiated a ride with Ted (our "water taxi" guy), please make sure you have pre-arranged the approx. meeting time with Ted, then contact him 30-minutes before arrival to let him know you are almost in Newboro: Ted Dwyer: 613-272-3438
